of King George the fourth intituled "An Act to provide for the Establishment  
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix  
a true and just composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or Payable  
within the Parish of Drumcanny in the County of Westmeath. Do hereby  
certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever  
within the said parish is Two hundred and Ninety pounds fifteen Shillings and  
four pence halfpenny British Currency by the year which sum of two hundred  
and Ninety pounds fifteen Shillings and four pence halfpenny by the year  
are due and Payable to the Reverend Mr Macode as Rector and Vicar  
of the said parish as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him  
And we do further certify that the average price of oats being the corn  
principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on  
the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty one  
is fifteen Shillings and one halfpenny per Barrel
