John Tanton sole commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of His present Majesty King William the 4th entitled "an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland and to make such composition permanent"; to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Drumat in the Diocese of Achonry and County of Sligo, do hereby certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two hundred and four pounds thirteen Shillings and eleven pence Sterling by the year of which Sum of Two hundred and four pounds thirteen Shillings and eleven pence The Sum of One hundred and nine pounds ten Shillings and eight pence are due and payable to the the Reverend John Garrett as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Vicar for the Vicarial Tithes of said Parish—

And that the Sum of Ninety five pounds three Shillings and three pence Sterling is due and payable to Robert Baker Esq^r for the Rectorial or Lay impropriate Tithes, as the Lessee of said Tithes under the Wills Assigns or Representatives of the late Sir Henry Montgomery Bart^l deceased—

And I do certify, that the average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in the County of Sligo for the Period of seven years ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty is Fifteen Shillings and three pence three farthings Sterling by the Barrel—
