 appointed and sworn as Commissioner under and  
 by virtue of an act made in the Fourth year of the  
 reign of King George the Fourth, entitled "An act  
 to provide for the establishing of compositions  
 for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" and  
 by virtue of an act passed in the second and  
 Third years of the reign of his Majesty King William  
 the fourth, entitled "An act to amend three  
 acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth  
 in the seventh and eighth years of the reign  
 of his late Majesty King George the Fourth,  
 provided for the establishing of compositions  
 for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such com-  
 positions permanent, and to ascertain and fix a  
 true and just composition for all tithes, arising  
 growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish  
 of Donegal, in the County of Kildare;" Do  
 hereby certify that the true and just amount  
 of composition for all tithes whatever within  
 the said parish is one hundred and thirty  
pounds, eighteen shillings, by the year, of which  
sum of £130. 18. 0, two thirds are due and pay-  
able to the Bishop of the Diocese of Kildare, as  
rector of the said Parish, and one third is  
due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Jos<sup>d</sup> Davcy, the  
Vicar of said Parish; And I do further certifi-
