of and in the lands and premises hereinafter mentioned
do hereby agree and undertake for the future payment
of the Tithe Compositions chargeable on all that and these
the Town and lands of Ballycree situated in the Parish of
Dungannon now in possession of my several under-tenants
bounded on the East by the lands of Kewath and Coolbeg
on the West by Killinacragh and Carrigwood on the North
Killinacragh and on the South by Ballinacree
containing by estimation 160 Acres or thereabouts pursuant
to the Provisions of 2nd & 3rd Will 4th Cap 119 deducting
therefrom 15th Cent per Annum I have therefore to request
you will furnish me with an Account of the Tithe
payable out of said lands and also with a certificate
required by the 22nd Section of the above named Act of
Parliament - dated this 10th February 1833
