

Whereas it appearing to us Nicholas Purcell Esq.erman Walter Mullony and Joseph Grene Esquires Justices of the Peace presiding at the Quarter Sessions for the Peace for the County of Kilkenny held at Graeco old Castle Kilkenny on the Twenty fourth day of June One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Six. That Mathew Keefe, John Doyle, John Maher, Charles Ryan and William Maher Owners or Occupiers of Land in the Parish of Dungarven in the Diocess of Ossory and County of Kilkenny charged with the payment of Three pounds or upwards each in respect of Composition for the in said Parish caused a Notice in Writing signed by them to be affixed on Sunday the fifth and Sunday the twelfth days of June One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Six on the Principal outer Door of the Church of said Parish of Dungarven the last of such Sundays not being less than Eight days previous to the day of holding the said Quarter Sessions for the Peace in the County of Kilkenny in which said Parish is Situate Signifying that it was their intention as such Owners or Occupiers of Land in the said Parish of Dungarven in the County of Kilkenny to make an Application to the Justices of the Peace at such Quarter Sessions to have the Average price of wheat for the Seven years preceding to be enquired of and ascertained in order that such Composition might be diminished for the ensuing Seven years in proportion to such Average price of Wheat. And Whereas the said Mathew Keefe, John Doyle, John Maher, Charles Ryan and William Maher as such Owners or Occupiers of Land in said Parish of Dungarven in the Diocess of Ossory and County of Kilkenny aforesaid charged with the payment of Three pounds sterling or upwards Composition for dythes having made an application in Writing to us the said Justices aforesaid presiding at the Quarter Sessions aforesaid held at Graeco old Castle in the County of Kilkenny in which said Parish is Situate on the Twenty fourth day of June One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Six to ascertain the average price of good marketable Wheat as advertised in the Dublin Gazette during the Seven years preceding their said Application. And Whereas the said Justices so proceeding as aforesaid having pursuant to the Statute in that case made and provided enquired into and ascertained by evidence the average price of a Barrell of good marketable Wheat as advertised in the Dublin Gazette upon the average of such term of Seven years preceding their said Application and having enquired if there was any appearance on the part of the Incumbent or of the Lay Impropriator of the said Parish of Dungarven and having made proclamation to that effect neither they or any person appeared on the part of them or either of them and there was no opposition made by the said Incumbent or Lay Impropriator or either of them to the proceedings in this behalf. And Whereas we the said Justices presiding as aforesaid at such Quarter Sessions held at Graeco old Castle aforesaid in the Diocess of Ossory and County of Kilkenny in which the said Parish of Dungarven is Situate having enquired and ascertained by evidence that the Average price of good marketable Wheat for the Seven years preceding the said Application from the Dublin Gazette to be One pound Eight Shillings and five pence half penny British per Barrell And that the average price of wheat per Barrell for the Seven years preceding the first of
