

Case with regard to the most recent one that  
I know of in <sup>Princetown</sup> ~~Princetown~~, the sale in the  
Landed Estates Court of Fitzmaurice's Estate -  
in which Roger Baker's lands were sold in 1868  
a portion of <sup>lot 2 in part</sup> ~~Tournon~~ was purchased by ~~him~~  
Fitzmaurice & subsequently disposed of by him  
by private sale to a Mr. E. Shaw. After Shaw  
nothing until quite recently as Fitzmaurice  
notwithstanding the sale continued to pay the  
rentcharge. When Fitzmaurice's property was sold  
in 1876 all the rentcharge pay all by him including  
what ought to have been on lot 2 above mentioned,  
was put on the lands then the subject of sale.

I have got this error corrected as well as I can  
by changing the apportionment on lot 5 bought by  
Sir Reginald Hurdle, charging him with 14/6 instead  
of 21. 10. 4 & Mr Shaw, who had been exempt, with  
14/6. This makes only £1. 9. 4 but there was 1/4 exp  
in the total amount in rental.
