made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth
intituled an Act to provide for the Composition of Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time, Do hereby Certify that we have diligently and
attentively looked over, and examined every Farm, and every
Division and Subdivision of each Farm in said Parish; and that
we have apportioned the Sum of Seven Hundred and Seventy
Pounds Sterling which the Rector is entitled to receive as
Composition for Tithes, In fair just and equitable proportions,
according to the Value of the Land, to the best of our Skill
and Judgment which proportions are correct as stated in the
 foregoing account - opposite the Name of each occupier. Given
under our hands this 28th day of April 1824
