

We William Willard and George Courtney, Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the fourth, intituled an Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to Ascertain, and fix, a true and just Composition for all Tithes Arising, Growing, Yielded, or payable within the Parish of Dungannon in the County of Cook, do hereby Certify, that the true and just Amount of Composition, for all Tithes whatsover within the said Parish is Seven hundred and twenty Pounds by the Year, which sum is due and payable to the Rev. Matthew Purcell as a Composition for the Tithe Claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish.

And we do further Certify, that the Average price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in said Parish, for the periods of seven Years, ending on the first day of November Eighteen hundred and twenty One is fifteen Shillings and two pence and the one seventh part of one penny per Bush.
