

At a Special Vestry held at the Parish Church of Danganoo  
 on Tuesday the 5th day of October Instant agreeable to legal  
 Notice to Carry into execution the purposes of an Act made  
 in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the fourth  
 entitled an Act to provide for Establishing Compositors for  
Fishes in Ireland for Unlimited time, when it appeared  
 upon a division of the Members Composing said Vestry that  
 a Majority were in favor of the New Fish Compositon  
 Bill. And that we therefore in pursuance of the provision  
 of said Act do Nominate and Appoint William Willand  
 Esq<sup>r</sup> <sup>of Killigh</sup> to act on the part of the Parishioners as Commissioner  
 And the Rev<sup>d</sup> Math<sup>w</sup> Purcell to nominate and appoints  
 George Courtney Esq<sup>r</sup> of Ballynaclashy as Commissioner  
 to act on his behalf, and that our Chairman Vice  
 Chancelor Esq<sup>r</sup> do forthwith communicate same to the  
 Lord Lieutenant and the Bishop of the Diocese.
