 Whereof Eighty four Pounds fourteen Shillings and eight pence Sterling is due and payable to the Rev^d James
 Strange Bishop of Down and of said Parishes thirteen Pounds eight Shillings and eight pence is due and payable
 to the Lord Bishop of Clogher as his Lordships proper tithes five Pounds Sterling is due and payable
 to the Reverend Bro: Haughton as Dean of the Drogheda of Clogher and we do hereby Certify that the
 Average price of Cobs being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of Six Years
 Ending the first day of November 1793 Twenty one is thirteen Shillings & six pence of the above
 Given under our hands this 9th day of Sept^r one thousand
 Eight hundred and twenty four
