the true and just amount of Composition for
all Tithes what - within such parish - is
Three hundred - and Fifty eight pounds -
Seventeen Shillings and five pence half penny
by the Year: the said of which sum is
due and payable to the Reverend Moore Morgan
as a Composition for the Tithes claimed by him
as Incumbent of said parish -

We further certify that the average price of
bats - being the Corn - principally grown in said
County - for the period of seven years - ending 1st
November 1821 - is fifteen Shillings and 2¹/₄
per Barrel.
