do hereby certify that the true and
just Amount of Compensation for all
Lithes whatever within the said Parishes
is Three hundred pounds payable by the
year which Sum of Three hundred pounds
is due and payable to John Watson of Northampton
Esq as a Compensation for the Lithes claimed
by him as by Impropriation of said Parishes
And we do further certify that the
Average price of Cuts being the Com-
mon price of Cuts in said County for the
period of seven years ending on the first day
of Nov^r 1821 and is fourteen Shillings and one
Penny
