

2nd and 3rd William 4th Chap 119

I John H. Watters a Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third year of the reign of King William the 4th Chap 119 entitled an Act to amend the Acts passed respectively in the Tenth Fifth and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent to ascertain and fix the true and just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Drumoylan in the County of Linnisk and Diocese of Linnisk Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two hundred and thirty five pounds Sterling of which sum of Two hundred and thirty five pounds Sterling the sum of one hundred and fifty six pounds thirteen shillings and four pence Sterling is due and payable to William Hogan Esq. the lessee of the right Honourable the Earl of Cork and Erris for the tithes claimable by him as lay Impropriator the sum of seventy eight pounds five shillings and eight pence Sterling is due and payable to the Reverend James W. Graves as Rector of said parish, and his Successors - and I do further certify that the average price of wheat and oats being the Com principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ended on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty - are for wheat per barrel of twenty stone one pound twelve shillings and a half penny British, and for oats per barrel of fourteen stone twelve shillings and eleven pence half penny British Given under my hand this Fifteenth Day of October One thousand eight hundred and thirty three -
