

Tithe Compositions

I Joseph Henry Mybrants having been duly appointed and sworn as Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time and by Virtue of an Act passed in the second and third years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the fourth intituled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eight years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent and to ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition for all Tithes arising growing or payable within the Parish of Drumma in the County of Offalldo certify that the true and Just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Eighty one Pounds Ten Shillings Sterling

By the year of which sum of £ 81.10.0 are due and payable to the Rev. Mr. Brabazon Disney as Rector of the Rectorial Tithes claimable by him in said Parish

And I do further certify that the average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ending the first day of November 1831 is thirty two Shillings and one halfpenny per Barrell given under my hand this 31<sup>st</sup> day of Aug<sup>r</sup> 1831 / Wm. J.
