

We the Commissioners appointed under the Tithe Composition Act to appraise and assess
in The Parish of Dummurry in the County and Diocese of Kildare the Sum of Seventy
five Pounds British Currency being the Amount of Composition agreed upon by the
Parishioners assembled in Vestry with The Rev^d Henry Hamilton Rector and Vicar of said Parish
equally on all the Lands in the Parish, have according to the best of our Judgment and
abilities viewed every farm and plot of ground and have set forth the quality of Land
contained in each as compared with the remainder of the Parish, and the gross amount
of Acres, Roods and Perches taken in nearly all cases from actual Survey either in possession
of the Landlord or occupying Tenant. We have divided the arable and pasture Land
into four qualities charging the 1st quality a 3⁰ 6 per Acre the 2^d do a 2⁰ 6 - the 3^d do
a 1⁰ 7 - and the 4th do a 1⁰ 1 - The Average Price of Wheat for seven years next
preceding 1821 one being 1⁰ 18 8 1/2 per Barrel -
