And we do further certify that the Average price  
of Oats being the corn principally grown in such  
County, for the period of Seven years, ending on the  
first day of November 1821 is Fifteen Shillings and  
two pence farthing old Irish currency of Parcel  
Dated this 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 1826 -
