the Fourth, intituled "An Act to Provide for the
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for
a limited Time" to ascertain and fix a true and just
Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded,
or payable within the Parish of Dunmanin in the County
of Kerry, do hereby certify, that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said
Parish is One Hundred and Fifty Pounds by the Year
of which sum of One Hundred and fifty Pounds, the entire
is due and payable to the Reverend Archibald Mackintosh
as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as
Rector of Said Parish

And we do further certify, that the Average Price of
Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in such County
for the Period of Seven Years, ending the 1st day of
November 1830 is Twenty shillings & 8 pence of Two bush Stone
to the Barrel. Dated this 4th day of February 1838
