priate tithes of such Part of said Parish as is commonly ~~called~~ known
by the name of Relishane and the further sum of Twenty Pounds
Ster. by the year is due and payable to the said Nathaniel
Swanson Esq. as Lessee of the Remaining Part of the Impropriate

Justices of such Part of said Parish as is commonly known by the name
of Relishane it having been also agreed upon that these several
Agreements shall be binding for the term of twenty one years without
any variation or alteration whatsoever and we do further certify that
the average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in
such County for the Period of seven years ending on the first
day of November 1821 twenty one was Thirty eight Shillings per
Barrell - given under our hands this 17th Day of April One
Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty -
