The Rev^d John Dawson as a Composition for the Tithes claimed
by him as Vicar of the said Parish, and the remaining half of
said sum of Five Hundred and Eighty five pounds fourteen shil-
lings and five pence is due and payable to the Bishop of
the Diocese of Kildalee as proprietor of the Rectorial
Tithes of said Parish
