I Robert Ormsby Commissioner duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an act passed in the 2<sup>d</sup> and 3<sup>d</sup> years of the reign of King William the 4<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>d</sup> of Queen Victoria to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Townlands of Upper and Lower Ballymeeny, in the Parish of Esky, and Diocese of Cillalla, in the County of Sligo, do hereby certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever, within the said Townlands of Ballymeeny, is Thirty one pounds, seven shillings and eight pence, by the year, and that, that sum is due, and payable to William Atkinson Esq. as Lay Impropriator of said Tithes.

And I do further certify that the average price of oats, being the corn principally grown in this County for the period of seven years, ending on the first day of November 1830, thirty, is twelve shillings and elevenpence halfpenny, per Barrel.
