 George the fourth providing for the Establishing of Composition for
 Tithes in Ireland and to make such Composition permanent
 to ascertainment and fix a true and just Composition for all
 Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of
 Eastly in the County of Sligo - do hereby Certify that the true and
 just Composition for all Tithes whatever within in the said Parish
 is Five Hundred and Eighty six pounds fourteen shillings and
 five pence by the year of which sum of Five Hundred and
 Eighty six pounds fourteen shillings and five pence the one
 half is due and payable to the Rev. John Dawson as a Composi-
 tion for the tithes claimed by him as Vicar of the said Parish
 and the remaining half of said sum of Five Hundred and
 Eighty six pounds fourteen shillings and five pence is due
 and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Killaloe
 as Proprietor of the Rectorial Tithes of said Parish -
