

We Thomas Weldon of Riversfield and John O'Donnell of
Kilbridey Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by
virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George
the fourth, intitled an Act to provide for the Establishment of
Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain
and file a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising
growing or payable within the Parish of Effin -
in the County of Limerick, do hereby Certify that the true and
just Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is three Hundred and twenty Pounds St^r by the
year which Sum of three Hundred and twenty Pounds St^r
has been unanimously agreed upon on the part of the owners
and Occupiers of Land within said Parish at a Special
Vestry held in the Parish on the 10th day of September 1820 -
to be invariably paid for 21 years to the Rev^d James Ellard
as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Prebendary
of said Parish and which has been approved of on the part of Lord
Dunraven Patron of the Living
dated Oct 10th 1820
