

We Thomas Weldon of Sweenfield and John O'Donnell of Kiltreedy Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth
year of the reign of King George the fourth, intituled, an act to provide for the establish-
ment of compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time, ascertain and file
a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing yielding or payable
within the Parish of Offin in the County of Limerick do hereby certify that the
true and just composition for all tithes whatever within the said parish is three
hundred and twenty ^{pounds} ~~by~~ by the year, which sum of three hundred and twenty
pounds ~~it~~ has been unanimously agreed upon on the part of the owners and
occupiers of land within said parish at a special vestry held in the Parish on
the 10th day of September 1828 to be invariably paid for 21 years to the Rev^d James
Ollard as a composition for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of said
parish and which has been approved of on the part of Lord Dunraven Patron of the living
