appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act
made in the fourth year of the reign of King George
the fourth, intituled "An Act to provide for the
Establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain and give a true
and ^{just} composition for all tithes arising, growing, yield-
or payable within the parish of Enlough in the
County of Meath, do hereby Certify that the true
and just amount of Composition for all tithes ~~payable~~
within the said parish is ninety pound by the year of
which sum of ninety pound, the whole is due and payable
to the Reverend Wm. North Shield as a composition for the tithes
claimable by him as Rector of the said parish -

And we do further Certify that the average
price of wheat being the com principally grown in
said County for the period of seven years ending on the
first day of November 1824 is one pound eight teen Shillings
and eight pence half penny, late Irish Currency, per Barrel.
