

We Charles Realy and Richard Ryan in suspension being appointed
and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth
year of the reign of King George the fourth, intituled, "An Act
to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for tithes in
Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and find a true and
just composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or
payable, within the parish of Anagh in the County of
Down, do hereby certify, that the true and just
amount of composition for all tithes whatsoever within the
said parish is ninety pounds by the year, of which being
ninety pounds the whole is due and payable to the Reverend
Walterworth Shield, as a composition for the tithes
claimable by him as Rector of the said parish.

And we do further certify that the average
price of wheat being the corn principally grown in
said County for a period of seven years ending on the
first day of November 1821 is one pound eight teen
shillings and eight halfpenny, late Irish currency, per Borell.
