

of Ettagh; and that the said sum is not below
the average amount of the sums actually
paid out of and upon the said Parish of
Ettagh for all the tithes thereof for the seven
years next preceeding the first of November
1821 and that the true and just amount
of Compensation for all tithes whatever
within the said Parish of Ettagh is one
One hundred and Fifty one Pounds agreed
upon as aforesaid by the year, the whole
of which sum of one hundred and Fifty
One Pounds is due and payable to the
said Rev Thomas Strange as Rector of the
said Parish of Ettagh.

And we the said Commissioners do
further certify that the average price of
wheat, being the Corn principally grown
in said Kings County for the seven
years ending on the first day of November
1821, is One Pound sixteen Shillings and
eight pence half penny per Barrel.
