We Rob<sup>t</sup> & Wm. Little Esq<sup>r</sup> Comm<sup>rs</sup>  
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue  
of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of  
King George the fourth entitled an act to provide for the  
establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a  
limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just com-  
position for all Tithes as arising growing yielding or  
payable within the ~~Span~~ Parish of Luke in the  
County of Kilkenny and part in the Queens County do  
hereby certify that the true and just demand for  
composition for all Tithes whatsoever within said Par-  
ish of Luke is seven hundred and fifty pounds so much  
by the Year which sum of seven hundred and  
fifty pounds is due and payable thereout to the  
Rev<sup>d</sup> John B. Ridge as Rector and Vicar of said  
Parish Invariably for Twenty one years and we do  
further certify that the average price of wheat  
being the corn principally growing in such County  
for the period of seven years ending on the first day  
of November eighteen hundred and twenty one accord-  
ing to the Schedule there of furnished by the Right  
Hon<sup>ble</sup> Henry Goulbourn Chief Secretary to the  
Lord Lieut. is one pound eighteen Shillings and the  
eight pence half penny per barrel - Dated this 19<sup>th</sup>  
day of December 1825
