We Robert Neville and John Little Esq^s Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth "entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of Composition for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tythes arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of Cirke in the County of Kilkenny and part in the Queen's County Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tythes whatever within said Parish of Cirke is Seven hundred and fifty pounds so much by the year which sum of Seven hundred and fifty pounds is due and payable thereout to the Rev^d John B. Ridge as Rector and Vicar of said Parish, Invariably for Twentyone years

And We do further Certify that the Average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such Counties for the period of Seven years ending on the first day of November Eighteen hundred and twentyone according to the Schedule thereof furnished by the Right Honourable Henry Goulbourn, Chief Secretary to the Lord Lieutenant is One pound Eighteen shillings and Eight pence halfpenny per Barrel
