being appointed and sworn under and by virtue of
an act, entitled an act to provide for the establish-
ment of composition for tithes in Ireland from limited
time, made in the fourth year of the reign of King George
the Fourth, to ascertain and fix a true & just com-
position for all tithes, arising, growing, yielded or
payable within the Parish of Easton now in the County
of Roscommon do hereby certify that the sum of thirty
two Pounds counterbalancing the sum of seed upon between
the Par & Thomas Poyford, Vicar, & the Parishes
of the Parish of Easton now in County Roscommon, is
a true and just amount of composition for all
tithes within the said Parish of which sum
eighteen Pounds seven shillings and
four pence ^{one half} is due and payable to
Edward Lord Gifford in composition for the tithes
