

We Richard Ryan & Francis Bratt Smith Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under & by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth intituled an Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the parish of Annisoffey in the County of Westmeath, do here by Certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes whatever within the said parish is one hundred and twenty two pounds by the year, of which sum of one hundred and twenty two pounds the whole is due and payable to Frederick and Hannah Blundell as a composition for the tithes claimable by them as lay Impropriators of the said parish -

And we do further Certify that the Average price of oats being the corn principally grown in such County, for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1820 is fifteen shillings and two pence one farthing per Barrel -
