

This Indenture Made the sixteenth day of July in the eighth year of the Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord William the third by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c Annoys Dom One thousand six hundred ninety six Betwene the Right Reverend Father in God William Lord Bishop of Derry of the one part and Adam Read Incumbent of the Vicaridge of the Parish of Fawne in the County of Donegall Clerke of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Lord Bishop of his pious intentions to the Church, and for advancing the worship of God, and the true Religion and for an addition to the maintenance of the Incumbent of the said Parish for the time being and for divers other good considerations him the said Lord Bishop thereunto especially moving Hath given and granted, and by these presents doth give and grant unto the said Adam Read and his successors Incumbents of the said Parish of Fawne, All and singular the Rectoriall Tythes of the said Parish of Fawne in the said County of Donegall in, as large and ample manner as the same were lately purchased by the said Lord Bishop from George Vaughan Esq<sup>r</sup> and are now by his Tennants enjoyed, To have, and to hold the said Rectoriall Tythes of the said Parish of Fawne in as large and ample manner, as the same were by the said Lord Bishop lately purchased and are now by his Tennant or Tennants enjoyed unto the said Adam Read and his successors Viccars of the said Parish for ever.
