year of the Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord William the Third by the
Grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King Defender
of the Faith so Amoye Com One thousand six hundred ninety six
Betweene the Rt Reverend Father in God William Lord
Bishop of Down of the one part and Adam Read Incumbent of the
Vicaridge of the Parish of Tawne in the County of Donegall Clerk of the
other part, witnesseth that the said Lord Bishop of his pious intentions
to the Church and for advancing the worship of god and the true
Religion and for an addition to the maintenance of the Incumbent of
the said Parish for the time being and for divers other good considerations
him the said Lord Bishop therewith especially moving hath given and
granted and by these presents doth give and grant unto the said
Adam Read and his successors Incumbents of the said Parish of
Tawne All and singular the Rectoriall Tythes of the said Parish
of Tawne in the said County of Donegall in as large and ample
manner as the same were lately purchased by the said Lord Bishop
from George Vaughan Esq^r and are now by his Tennants enjoyed
To have and to hold the said Rectoriall Tythes of the said
said Parish of Tawne in as large and ample manner as the same
were by the said Lord Bishop lately purchased and are now by his
Tennant or Tennants enjoyed, unto the said Adam Read and his
Successors Vicars of the said Parish for ever, to the only use and
 behoofe of the said Adam Read and his successors Vicars of the said
Parish for evermore, And the said Lord Bishop doth hereby covenant
