Parish — It having been also agreed upon at  
the said Vestry that the said whole sum of ~~the~~ <sup>annually</sup> ~~houses~~  
pounds be paid, in lieu of all tithes, for the term of twenty  
- one years without any variation or alteration whatever —

And we do further Certify that the ~~present~~ average price  
of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in such  
County, for the period of Seven years ending <sup>in</sup> the  
first day of November 1821 one, was Thirty: eight  
- Shillings per Barrel —
