Sir

You will please to take notice that pursuant to the provisions of the Statute of the 2^d and 3^d years of the Reign of his present Majesty King William the Fourth entitled An Act to amend Three Acts passed respectively in the 1st, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth - providing for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland - and to make such Compositions permanent - I propose hereby to undertake the future payment of all Compositions for Tithes due and payable to the Reverend the Vicar Choral of the Cathedral Church of St. Peter Barris, Cork - out of that part of the lands of Mobery called Caphodimus in the Parish of Paulinus - Barony of the best division of East Carbery and County of Cork - which I hold under and by Virtue of a Lease for Three Lives and Thirty one years in two terms - Bounded on the North and East by the Lands of Mobery crops - on the South by the Lands of Milltown and on the West by other parts of the lands of Caphodimus all in this Parish - a Map or ground plan whereof is herewith annexed - and also that I will undertake the future payment of all Compositions for Tithes due and payable to the said Reverend Vicar Choral out of the lands of Callinagh in this Parish which I hold under and by Virtue of a Lease for Three Lives - Bounded on the West and partly on the South by parts of the Parish of Drimoleague - on the South also by the Lands of Courtreen - on the East by the lands of Derrydun and Callaluna and on the North by the lands of Brownedcastle ~~Spence and Gualabillan~~ all in this Parish - a Map or ground plan whereof is herewith annexed -
