year of the Reign of King George the Fourth
intituled "an Act to provide for the Estab-
lishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a
true and just Composition for all Tithes arising
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish
of Tarrish in the County of Cork.

Do Certify that the true and just amo-
-unt of Composition for all Tithes ~~Whatsoever~~
within the said Parish is Four Hundred and
Ten Pounds ¹⁰ s. by the year and which said
Sum of Four Hundred and Ten Pounds by the
year is Due and payable to the Reverend
Thomas John Burgh as a Composition for all
Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Pa-
-rish, and we do further Certify that the Ave-
-rage Price of Oats being ^{from} the ~~principally~~
grown in the County of Cork for the Period of
Seven Years ending in the last November One
Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty one is Fifteen
Shillings 4 2/3 Pence
