A Special Vestry, duly assembled  
in the Parish of Lumbry in the Diocese of Gloucestre  
and County of Cork on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Day of December  
1830 Pursuant to the Provisions of the said  
Compensation Acts for the purpose of taking  
into consideration the Certificate of Compensation  
for the Tithe of said Parish

We Do hereby signify on behalf of the owners  
and occupiers of Lands within said Parish our  
Assent to the payment of the Amount of the  
Compensation contained in the Compendious Ver-  
dicate as submitted to our consideration bear-  
ing Date the 26<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1830 being  
for the sum of four hundred & Ten Pounds  $\text{£}410$   
by the year and made payable to The Rev<sup>d</sup>  
James The Burch for all Tithe Claimants  
to and to him as Rector of said Parish

Also we also signify our consent on behalf  
of the owners and occupiers of Lands in said  
Parish, that such compensation shall be <sup>in its full</sup> payable  
for the term of <sup>years</sup> twenty from its commencement  
whenever the full term of term may be in the  
mean time
