this 26<sup>th</sup> day of April 1874

Whereas by a Certificate made and  
dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year  
1834 James Fraser the Commissioner  
duly appointed and sworn under and  
by virtue of the several acts of Parliament  
therefore made and provided for  
establishing Tithe Composition in Ireland  
to ascertain and fix a true and just
