

Sir you are hereby required to take notice  
that, in pursuance of an Act passed in the  
second and third year of his present Majesty,  
entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed res-  
pectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh  
and eight years of the reign of his late Majesty,  
King George the fourth, providing for estab-  
lishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland  
and to make such compositions permanent,  
Francis Bruen of Rodbawn, in the County of Wick,  
being seized in fee simple of all the lands  
situate in the Parish of Terns  
Barony of Scenawick and County of Wick  
or otherwise entitled according to the provisions of said  
Act, to agree for, and undertake the payment of the  
composition for tithes, lawfully payable for and in respect of  
such lands do hereby signify to you my desire to agree for  
and undertake the payment of such composition as aforesaid  
for and in respect of the said lands, and I hereby require you to  
grant me a certificate, in writing, conformable to the provisions  
of said Act, declaring me entitled to the benefit of this Act  
and to perform the other matters on your part required by the Act  
to be done.
