 virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of
 King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide for the
 Establishment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
 time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for
 all Tithes as arising, growing, yielded, or payable within
 the Parish of Fertagh in the County of Kilkenny, do hereby
 Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for
 all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Four
Hundred & twenty five pounds Sterling
 by the year which sum of Four hundred & twenty five pounds
 is due and payable to the Reverend Richard Basley Vaughan
 as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish of Fertagh as a composition
 for Tithes claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of said Parish
 And we do further Certify that the average price of
 Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for
 the period of seven years ending on the first day of December Eighteen
 hundred and twenty five according to the Schedule thereof furnished
 by the Right Honble Henry Goulson Chief Secretary to the
 Lord Lieutenant of Ireland, as one pound Eighteen Shillings
 and eight pence half penny per Barrel
