Commissioners Certificate for the parish of Terliamagh

We the Reverend William Edward Lloyd of Holy Cross Glebe in the County of Tipperary and William Palmer of Harcourt Street in the City of Dublin Esq<sup>r</sup> Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth Year of the reign of King George the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Terliamagh in the Arch Diocese of Cashel and County of Tipperary. And hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever within the said parish pursuant to an agreement made between Richard Lord Arch Bishop of Cashel and the Special Vestry for said parish is the sum of Two Hundred pounds by the year which sum of Two Hundred pounds is due and payable to the most Reverend Richard Lord Arch Bishop of Cashel as a composition for the Tithe claimable by Him as Rector and Vicar of the said parish And We do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 - agreeable to the Schedule thereof furnished by the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> Henry Goulburn Chief Secretary to the Lord Lieutenant of Ireland is One pound Eighteen Shillings and Eight pence halfpenny per Barrel
