We Thomas Cannon and George Fisher
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and
by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the
Reign of King Ge^o. Fourth Entituled an Act to provide
for the Establishing a Composition for all tithes arising growing
yielded and payable to within the Parish of Friendstown
in the County of Wicklow do hereby Certify that as it appears
that the Parishioners of Friendstown and the Incumbent
have with the concurrence of the Archbishop of the Diocese
Mutually agreed that the Composition for tithes due
Incumbent shall be Twenty eight pounds by the year
for twenty one years from first November 1824 The said
sum of Twenty Eight pounds shall be according to the
Amount of the Composition of one third of all the Tithes
of said Parish to which he the Reverend Moore Morgan
as Ecclesiastical Incumbent is entitled and we further
Certify that the average price of Oats being the corn principally
grown in the said County for the period of seven years ending
on the first day of November 1824 is fifteen shillings and
two pence fashung per Barrel 5th October 1824 signed
