Certify that the Sum of Fifty six pence fifteen
shillings - is due and payable by the year, to John
Green Esq of Mountfield in the County of Wick as
a Composition for the proportion of Tithe claimable
by him as Lessee under the Dean and Chapter
of St Patrick's Dublin - of which Parish The Rev^d
Moore & Morgan is Incumbent -

And we further Certify that the average price
of oats being the Corn principally grown in such
County for the period of seven years ending the
first of November 1821 is fifteen shillings and
two pence farthings by the Barrel
