

of the Archbishop of the Diocese
Mutually agreed that the com-
position for Tithes due In-
-cumbent shall be Twenty-
-eight pounds by the Year
For twenty one years from first
of November 1824. and that
The said sum of twenty eight
pounds / late Irish currency
shall be accordingly the amount
of the composition of one third
of all the Tithes of said parish
to which he the Rev. Moore Morgan
as Ecclesiastical Incumbent is
entitled. And whereas it appears
that the Dean & Chapter of St.
Patrick's Cathedral in the Diocese
of Dublin aforesaid are entitled
to two thirds of all the tithes arising
growing, yielded and payable

within the said Parish of Friends
Town, in the County Wicklow a-
-foresaid, we do hereby certify
that the sum of ¹⁰fifty six pounds
late Irish currency shall be the
Amount of two thirds of all the
tithes of said Parish to which the
said Dean & Chapter shall be
entitled.

And we further certify that
the average price of oats, being
corn principally grown in the
County for the period of seven years
ending on the first day of November
1821, was fifteen and two pence
fourthing per Barrel
Dublin 27th April 1836
