We John Falkner and Pierce Tho. Gold Commissioners  
duly appointed and sworn, under and by Virtue of an Act  
made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the 4th  
"intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Com-  
positions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time"  
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for  
all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within  
the Parish of Finis in the County of Tipperary. Do hereby  
certify that the true and just amount of composi-  
tion for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish  
is two hundred <sup>and</sup> Seventy pounds British Currency  
by the Year, which sum is due and payable to the  
Rev. Pierce Gold, as a Composition for the tithes  
claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said  
Parish. And we do further certify that the average  
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in  
such County for the period of seven years ending on  
the 1<sup>st</sup> of Nov. 1824, is Thirty eight Shillings and  
eight pence half penny per Bush.
