We John Tallman and Pierce Thos. Gould Com-  
missioners duly appointed and sworn under and  
by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the  
Reign of King George the fourth, intituled and Act  
to provide for the establishing of Compositions for  
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain  
and fix a true and just Composition for all  
Tithes, arising, growing, yielded, or payable within  
the Parish of Finis in County of Lifford. do  
hereby Certify, that the true and just amt. of Com-  
position for all tithes whatever within the said  
Parish is two hundred and seventy pounds with  
tithes Currency by the year, which sum is due &  
payable to the Rev. Pierce Gould as a Composition  
for the tithes claimable by him as Rector & Vicar  
of the said Parish. and we do further Certify, that the  
average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown  
in such County, for the period of seven years, ending  
on the first of November 1821. is Thirty eight Shillings and  
eight pence half penny (Signed) John Tallman
