that the true and Just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whateves within the said Parish is one Hundred and forty
Pounds by the year of which sum of one Hundred and
forty Pounds one half is due and payable to Thomas Staughton
Esq. as Lay impropriator and the other half is due and payable
to the Rev. Anthony Staughton as Vicar

And we do further certify that the average
price of wheat being the Corn (together with oats) principally
grown in such County for the period of seven years ending
on the 29th day of September last is thirty Shillings per
Banel of Twenty Stone being at the rate of one Shilling
and six pence per Stone and that the average price of oats
being the Corn also principally grown in such County for the said
period of seven years ending the 29th day of September
last is fifteen Shillings per Banel. Dated this 14th day
of October 1824.
