& sworn, under & by virtue of an Act made in the 2^d & 3^d
years of the Reign of King William the 4th intituled
An Act to amend 3. Acts passed respectively in the
4th 5th 7th & 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty
King George the 4th providing for the establishing of
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland & to make such Com-
positions permanent to ascertain & fix a true & just
Composition within the Parish of Tullistown in the
County of Meath, do hereby Certify that the true & just
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Thirty six Pounds by the year, which
sum of Thirty six Pounds is due & payable to Francis
Murphy Esq. as a Composition for the Tithes claimable
by him as owner of the Rectorial Tithes of said Parish,

And I do further Certify that the Average Price of Oats
being the Grain principally grown in such County
for the Period of 7 years ending 1 November 1830
is Thirteen Shillings & three pence three farthings & a half.
