Amount of Compensation for all Oats whatever
in said Parish is Two hundred & twenty Pounds
one half is due & payable to Thomas Stoughton
Esq. as owner of the Rectorial Oats & one half
is due & payable to the Rev. Auth^r Stoughton
Vicar of said Parish - And we further certify that
the Average Price of Oats being the Corn principally grown
in such County for the period of seven years ending on
the 1st day of Nov: 1821 is fifteen Shillings per Barrel
Given under our hands this 23rd day of Aug: 1825
