as Lay Impropriator And by Order  
of said Justices then and there made  
It was ordered that the average price  
of wheat (being the Com in said  
original certificate of said Herbert  
O'Donnell mentioned for the seven  
years preceding the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November  
1896 be inquired of and ascertained  
from the Dublin Gazette in order  
that the composition and the rent  
charge now payable in lieu thereof  
in said Parish may be varied and  
increased or diminished for the seven  
years ensuing 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1896  
in proportion to such average price  
and Edward Heard, Esquire, of  
Ballytubber, Carrigrohilly in the  
County

County of Cork was appointed an  
arbitrator for ascertaining the average  
price of the barrel of good marketable  
Wheat for the said term of seven years  
and was ordered to ascertain said  
average price from the Dublin Gazette  
for said term and to state and set forth  
such average price by his Report in  
writing under his hand and to deliver  
said Report to the Justices of the  
Peace of said County of Cork assembled  
at their present General Quarter Sessions  
of the Peace and the further hearing  
of said application was then and there  
duly adjourned to these present Sessions  
And whereas said Edward Heard  
said Arbitrator has by his Report in  
writing under his hand dated the  
14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1897 stated and  
certified that he has ascertained from  
the Dublin Gazette the average price  
of the barrel of good marketable Wheat  
for said period of seven years preceding  
1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1896 and that
