Ireland and the said Sessions to
which said application was first
made as aforesaid having been duly
Continued thence herewith for the
purpose of said application now
upon proof of the promise being made
to our satisfaction and upon reading
said Report in writing under his hand
of said Edward Heard the arbitrator
appointed as aforesaid whereby it
appears that the average price of
good marketable Wheat for the period of
seven years preceding the 1st November
1896 as ascertained from the Dublin
Gazette is $16 \frac{5}{8}$ the barrel and
upon hearing what was urged by
Counsel for said applicants and by
Counsel for said Provincial Bank
of Ireland We the Justices of the
Peace for the County of Cork assembled
at these General Quarter Sessions of
the Peace in and for said County
and in and for Cork County East Riding
and

and Division of Middleton (being the
County Riding and Division in which
said Parish of Gorrane kinnefeale is
situated) hereby find and determine that
the average price of the barrel of
good marketable Wheat being the
one stated in said original Certificate
of said Herbert O'Donnell for the term
of seven years next preceding 1st
November 1896 as ascertained from the
Dublin Gazette is $16 \frac{5}{8}$ and that
said average price varies by more than
a tenth from the average price in
said original Certificate of the said
Herbert O'Donnell stated And we
the said Justices do hereby further order
and adjudge that the composition
for all tithes and the rent charge now
payable in lieu thereof in said
Parish of Gorrane kinnefeale payable
to the Lay Impropriator for said term
of years ~~shall~~ be varied and diminished
for the term of seven years next
beginning the 1st day of November 1896
in such manner and to such extent
that the amount of said composition
payable to the Lay Impropriator for
said
